Having lived in Jacksonville for just under five years, **Adam Chaskin** (LJ 2021) feels fortunate to have experienced the LJ flagship program. "The people I have met through the program have become personal friends, business associates, mentors, mentees, and some, all of the above." Adam discovered LJ from his JCA Board members who had experienced the program and raved about the benefits. "Ultimately it was **David Miller** (LJ 2008) who explained the great benefits of the program and encouraged me to apply."

"The most impactful part of the LJ program was the 'crash course' in Jacksonville history (the good, bad and the ugly) coupled with how and where the nonprofit community plays a role alongside with the rest of the community. The program really opened my eyes to Jacksonville's potential.

"Last year after the antisemitic incident at the Florida/Georgia game, **Eric Mann** (NLS 2012) and I spoke about the need for our organizations to come together and educate people in our community. That led to our staffs coming together and the creation of the six month series **Together Against Hate**, in which we focus on a different form of hate each month. Our goal is to educate people and help break down the barriers that have caused hate.

"We all have a goal of living in a better place, and helping each other. LJ provided an opportunity for me to ensure that my agency is a leader in accomplishing these goals," Adam shared.
