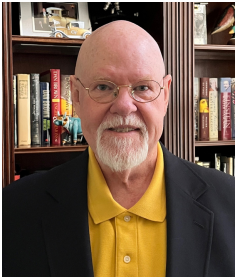

**Wade Barnes:** Wade Barnes (LJ 1995) led a successful career as an Obstetrical and Gynecology Consultant with North Florida Ob-Gyn Associates delivering more than 9,000 babies, and retired in June 2018. In 2014, Wade became the Medical Director for the Sexual Assault Forensic Exam (SAFE) program at the Women’s Center of Jacksonville. In this volunteer role, Wade helped build a program focusing on best practices in forensic exams, and volunteers with staffing cases, reviewing charts, and meeting with nurses. In 2018, Wade was named Advocate of the Year for the State of Florida by the Office of the Attorney General, and that same year, a tribute ceremony was held in Wade’s honor at the State Capitol during Victims’ Rights Week. Wade currently serves as a director emeritus for the Florida State College of Jacksonville Foundation.



**Debbie Buckland** (LJ 2009) is the Senior Vice President, Area Manager, Client Advisory at Pinnacle Financial Partners. She has more than 40 years of experience in financial services, most recently as Market President at Truist Bank. Debbie is currently the chair of the Jacksonville Transportation Authority, a board member of Baptist Beaches, trustee of WJCT Public Media and a past chair of the JAX Chamber, Downtown Vision, Inc., Jacksonville Women’s Business Center, and the American Cancer Society. In 2019, she was inducted into the First Coast Business Hall of Fame, and honored by Downtown Vision, Inc. with the Downtown Achievement Award. Debbie has also been recognized as a Woman of Distinction by Girl Scouts of Gateway Council; one of Jacksonville’s Women Making a Difference by the Mayor’s Commission on the Status of Women (2011); and a Woman of Influence by the Jacksonville Business Journal (2006).



**Eric Mann:** Eric Mann (NLS 2012) has served as president and CEO of the YMCA of Florida’s First Coast since 2011. Serving in YMCAs across the country, he has been part of the organization for more than 40 years. Eric became the first African American leader of Florida’s First Coast YMCA and as such, he also became the first African American CEO of a major metropolitan YMCA south of the Mason-Dixon Line. Last spring, Eric was elected by the membership of the Jacksonville Civic Council (JCC) to become its sixth chairman of the board. Eric is also chair of the Brooks Rehabilitation board, and an active board member for Baptist Medical Center, Fifth Third Bank, Patriot Transportation, Inc., Timuquana Country Club, Mars Hill University, and Tiger Academy Charter School.
